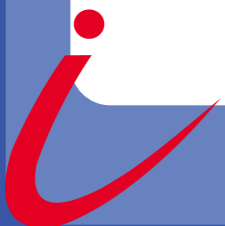
POP Mailbox

- Classic mailbox
- POP3 downloads
- Webmail access
- Outgoing authenticated SMTP on port 25 and 587
- No multidrop / “mail spooling”
- Anti-virus and anti-spam
- R29 per mailbox



Hosted Exchange

- Microsoft Exchange capabilities
- Lite @ R45 per mailbox – standard mail functionality as per POP mailbox with IMAP access
- Premium @ R75 per user – full Outlook functionality and integration including OWA
- ActiveSync license included
- Anti-virus and anti-spam
- Mail filtering service @ R15 per user
- Archiving bolt-on @ R35 per user
- Blackberry synchronization bolt-on @ R45 per user
- Domain administrative interface for mailbox management included

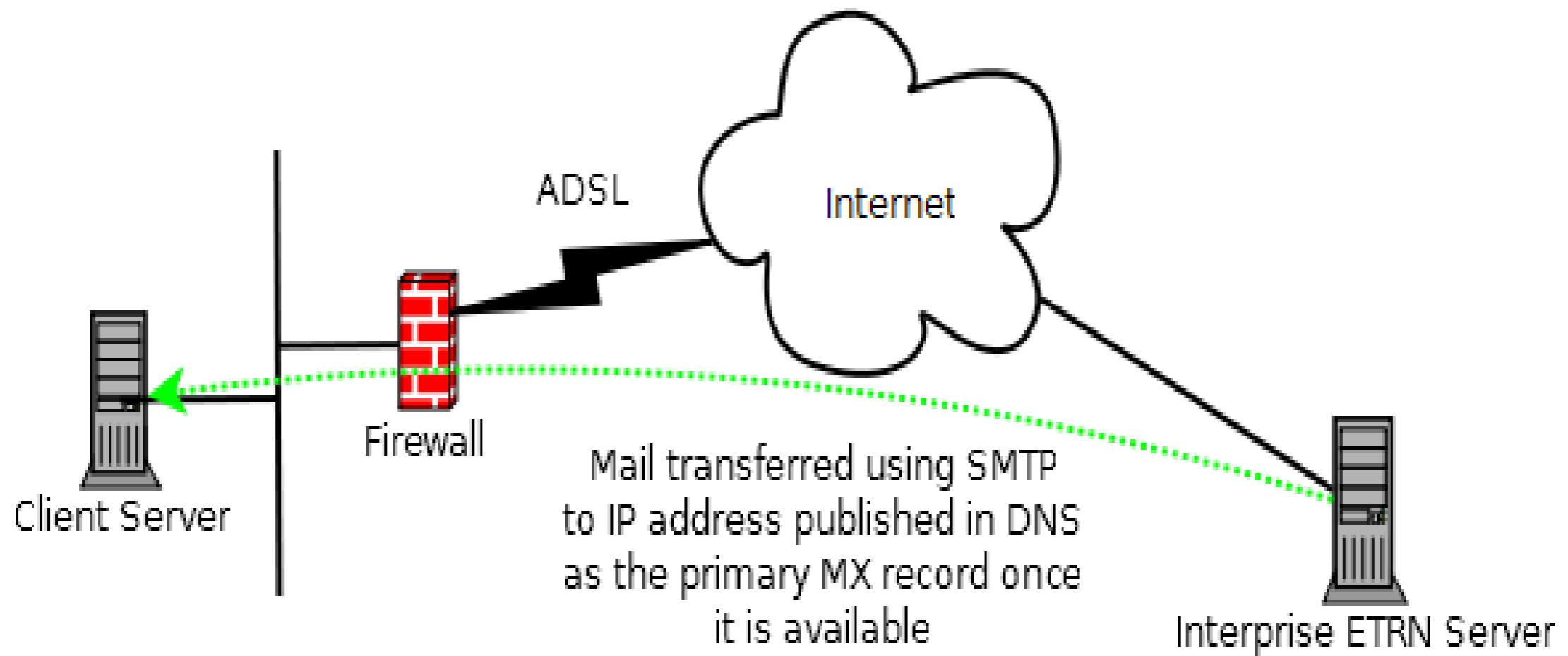


ETRN

- Secondary MX record for domain
- Require static IP address for primary MX record
- Dynamic DNS not recommended for primary
- Used in scenario where client has a mail server on their premises and wants to have the ability to initiate a de-queue process on the backup server and they have a connection type with a static IP address associated with it, e.g. Uncapped ADSL, Diginet, iBurst Static, Static dial-up
- Has the advantage of being a well supported, standardized and secure process, however it is not flexible and relies on the primary connection coming up in order to retrieve queued mail
- R200 per domain including 1GB mail throughput, R50 per GB thereafter



ETRN Diagram



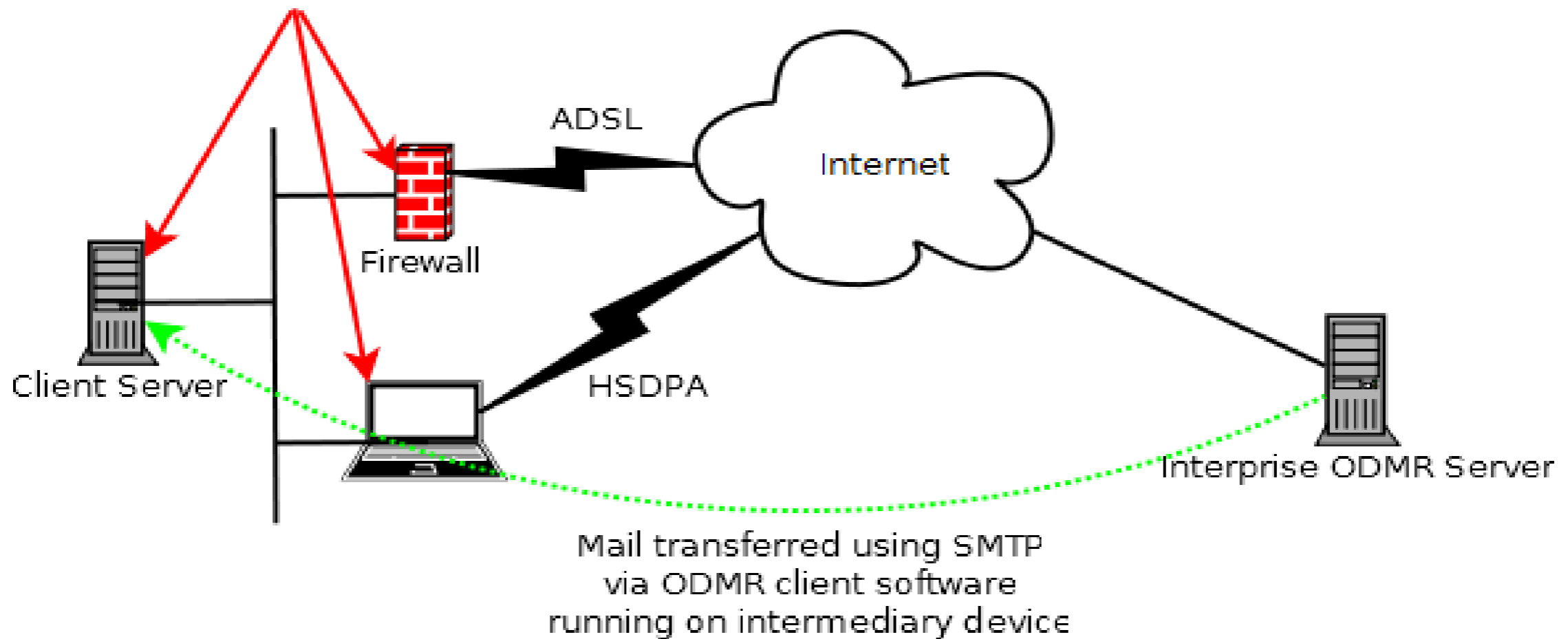
ODMR

- On-Demand Mail Relay
- Authenticated access
- No static IP address required
- 3rd party application required for certain mail servers, however it works with all functioning mail servers
- Can be used as a backup solution for a primary mail server or as the primary mail solution in itself. The lack of dependency on a static IP address makes it the best solution for being able to download queued mail to your mail server with any available connectivity type.
- R200 per domain including 1 GB mail throughput, R50 per GB thereafter

ODMR Download software can be configured on certain firewalls, intermediary devices like laptops, or on the mail server itself.
